- Detailed Analysis of Key Issue Areas in the Budget: The Toolkit includes detailed looks at what's in the proposed FY 2019 budget for early childhood development, PreK-12 education, affordable housing, homeless services, health care, employment and training, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), and Interim Disability Assistance (IDA).
- **Tips on Understanding the Budget and Getting Involved:** The Toolkit also includes a timeline of the budget process and how to get involved, as well as primers to understand how the city sets its budget, how it raises revenues, and how schools are financed.
