**Mayor releases FY** 2022 budget

DCFPI / DC Action poll on tax increase ••• shows 4 out of 5 of DC voters continue to support raising taxes on the wealthy

organizes almost 50 supporters to in support of raising revenue. DCFPI helps supporters prep testimony with toolkit and office hours

DCFPI dispels the tax flight myth and supplies Councilmembers with data on income and migration by race and ethnicity

Just Recovery collaborates with housing and early education partners to determine new revenue funding priorities

Fair Budget Coalition & Just Recovery publish Tax Platform with FY 2022 tax equity and revenue demands

July

DCFPI releases two videos on tax equity to educate the public and rally support before the first budget vote

> Councilmembers Allen, Lewis George, and Nadeau co-introduce amendment to increase taxes on DC's wealthiest. Amendment passes 8-5

Just Recovery DC organizes the People's Hearing on Revenue with testimonies from directly impacted residents & over 70 attendees

Just Recovery DC hosts Tax Justice Teach-In, training more than 50 supporters on tax equity

In the FY 2022 budget season. Just Recovery DC campaign partners drove 175 calls and 1,463 emails to lawmakers.

> DC Council unanimously approves FY 2022 budget, including amendment raising taxes

### March

DCFPI publishes report showing DC's wealthiest pay lower taxes than everyone else

DCFPI kicks off legislative campaign for tax justice, cultivating champions and supporters on DC Council

### **February**

DCFPI hires Just Recovery Organizer to recruit individuals and organizations to the campaign

Just Recovery DC WINS \$170 million in new annual local revenue

- Housing for 2,500 households
- Equitable pay for early childhood educators
